In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Act 1996, as amended, and the Waste Management (Permit) Regulations 1998, Louth County Council grants this waste permit under Article 5(1) of the said Regulations to **The Recycling Village Ltd, Tinure Business Park, Tinure, Monasterboice, Co Louth** to carry on at Units 4, 4A & 7, Tinure Business Park, Tinure, Monasterboice, Co Louth the waste activities listed below, subject to ten conditions, with the reasons therefore and the schedules attached thereto set out in the permit.

Permitted Activities, in accordance with the First Schedule  
of the Waste Management (Permit) Regulations 1998:

*Activity 2: The recovery of scrap metal or other metal waste*

This activity is limited to the permitted classes of waste recovery activity, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996, as amended, as listed and limited below.

*Activity 4: The recovery of waste which is composed of or contains mercury or its compounds (including electric lamps, light bulbs and fluorescent tubes)*

This activity is limited to the permitted classes of waste recovery activity, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996, as amended, as listed and limited below.

Permitted Waste Recovery Activities, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule  
of the Waste Management Act 1996 (as amended):

*Class 3 (Principal Activity) Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds*

This activity is limited to the reclamation of metals and metal compounds from the dismantling of electrical and electronic equipment at the facility.

*Class 4 Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials*


This activity is limited to the reclamation of inorganic wastes from the dismantling of electrical and electronic equipment at the facility.

*Class 13 Storage of waste intended for the submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced*

This activity is limited the storage of waste electrical and electronic equipment at the facility and to the storage of other permitted inorganic wastes at the facility prior to removal off-site for recovery.
